



BACKGROUND:

Malda district is a backward district declared by Ministry of Panchayati Raj, Govt. of India Moreover, north Malda is more backward than south Malda. The majority of its inhabitants are of village dwelling poor Muslim Minority Community, Scheduled Caste, OBC and other backward community people. According to different Government reports (Sachar, Mishra etc. Committee), Muslim community in India is a backward community; their socio-economic condition is even worse than that of the Scheduled Castes! Needless to mention that the Scheduled Castes are the downtrodden castes in India.

Education is the only key to all progress. Government schools are far behind in meeting the need of quality education. Whereas, the private schools are doing more business with education, they are least concerned for society or for quality of education. In this scenario the condition of the majority population in this rural area, particularly who are generally poor, is pathetic! In this background M. J. MEMORIAL SCHOOL (MJMS) is established at this much more backward area on 2nd January, 2016 for uplifting these citizens of our country. Waresin Ara Begom Amin saw her generosity and love for education by donating land in favour of this school. Now the School has vast land on which sufficient infrastructure (including more than 10 thousand square feet built up area, big modern auditorium, rich library, computer lab., hygiene laboratory, playground etc.).

On 1st June, 2019 the School was shifted on its own present land and buildings in a vast open greenery adjacent to the main road on the bank of fresh village-stream, Satmoniya. This year, on the 10th year of the school set up, it has secured the much desired prestigious affiliation from the West Bengal Board of Secondary Education as an English Medium Co-educational School. M. J. MEMORIAL SCHOOL is a modern English Medium High School now in the truest sense with all the modern amenities and provisions needed for achieving the best quality human resource production through the best quality teaching-learning and holistic guidance.

TEACHER-STUDENT RATIO:

In order to provide the best quality of education teacher's individual attention to each learner is a must. In order to ensure it, Teacher: Student ratio is maintained at 1:27 in the classroom i.e., one teacher is devoted to only about 27 students in a class room/section.

CLASSES:

The school was started with only two classes – NURSERY & K.G. (Kindergarten) and upgrades one class every year. In the present academic year 2025, total student strength (up to class IX) is 398. In the coming session (2026) the highest class will be X, starting from Nursery. Direct admission will be done only in Nursery and K.G. classes. However, few students may be admitted in upper classes (up to IX) through Admission Test only.

HOSTELFACILITY:

MJMS has started Students' (Boys') Hostel in the school campus from 2nd August, 2021. Well qualified and experienced teachers from Kolkata and around are residing in this hostel along with the student boarders. At present 4 numbers of residential teachers are deputed for only 13 numbers of student boarders. The residential teachers give academic coaching and all-round perfect guidance to the residential students beyond school-hours as well as cater quality education to the day students of this school during the school hour. We ensure a very good hostel and campus environment congenial for children's holistic development.

School's Hostel (Boys') facility is available for the students from classes I to X as well as for the residential teachers.

DAY STUDENTS' COACHING FACILITY:

The School provides coaching facility to our non-residential students also in the morning time, 7 to 9 pm daily (except Sunday). Provision for day meal is also available for the non-residential students at minimized cost.

A complete English-speaking environment is maintained in the Hostel and Campus. Students avail and enjoy Computer Lab. with Wifi enabled campus.

NEGLIGIBLE DROPOUTRATE:

Although the School is situated in a rural hinterland with more than 90 per cent of its firstgeneration learners, but its dropout rate is miraculously negligible. This is one of the achievements of this School.

ADMISSION:

In order to ensure quality, admission is restricted only in Nursery & K.G. Classes. In higher classes, if vacancy arises, few potential students may be admitted through Admission Test only. Admission process starts on and from 18th October and continues up to 15th December. Admission form along with the prospectus issued from the office counter of the school within school hours as well as can be downloaded from our school's website: www.mjm-school.com Duly filled-in admission form along with the relevant documents should be submitted within the stipulated period. Permissible age for admission in Nursery Class is 3.5 to 4.5 years and for K.G. it is 4.5 to 5.5 years. Suitable candidates are selected through personal interview with the parents and child.

ADMISSION IS OPEN TO ALL:

Any child from any Caste, Community, Religion, Gender, Region, Locality etc. can take admission at M. J. MEMORIAL SCHOOL subject to the fulfilment of age and other general criteria of the school.

GROWTH RATE OF STUDENTS INTAKE:

Students' admission in this School is consistently increasing since its inception one decade ago. The admission graph below illustrates this impressing truth!




Fig.: Graph showing consistently increasing students' intake capacity at MJMS since its inception.





Fig. : Bar Diagram of the MJMS Result Since Inception




Fig.: MJMS provides congenial environment to flourish self-confidence and leadership quality

EVALUATION:

Students' progress is being measured following the latest CCE (Continuous and Comprehensive Evaluation) mode. A monthly test is held at the end of every month and Semester Examinations are conducted at required interval as per the WBBSE norm. Semester marks get reflected in the CCE mark-sheets of each learner and these bear due weightage in the evaluation decision. Attendance in all the Semester and Class Tests is mandatory to each learner, exception only in emergent situation.

ATTENDANCE:

MJMS puts maximum emphasis on classroom teaching – learning. So, attendance in school is a must for every learner. Student remaining absent for two or more consecutive days without valid/emergent reason will invite appropriate disciplinary action from the part of the management.

SCHOOLRULES & DISCIPLINES:



- To construct separate campus for Girls' School.






